Opt-In to Receive Text Alerts

GMA uses a mass-communication system called OneCall to send out school-wide communications such as The GMA Gazette, weather related school delays/closings, announcements, reminders, and more. All families are added to this system automatically at the time of enrollment using the email address provided on the enrollment application.

You may also opt-in to receive alerts via text/phone call when appropriate. If you have already been receiving text/phone alerts from last year, there is no need to optin again. However, if you are new to GMA or did not receive text/phone alerts last year, you may wish to opt-in for this year.

To make this easy for you, we have created a phone alert that will dial the cellular phone number in our system to deliver the information you need to opt-in for this service. We do not share your number with anyone. This is strictly for us to share important/urgent information within our school community.

If you need to add a cell phone number for your family to this alert system please email Ms. Beth at blarock@gma.k12.in.us or call the front office. Then you will need to follow the opt in instructions below from that phone number.

Car Line Reminders

Please help us keep our car line running safely and as efficiently as possible. Our staff works hard to make sure that your children are safe at school from the moment they arrive on our campus until the moment they leave with you. Please be mindful of the fact that you are setting an example for them by making sure to follow all of the car line procedures and expectations with a positive attitude. Here are a few key reminders:

- Please pull all the way forward to allow as many cars in line as possible. This helps us make sure we are not backing up traffic on 900N.
- Cell phones should not be used during car line.
- Children are to remain seated until your vehicle is stopped and staff have signaled for your child(ren) to dismiss
- Do not change lanes during car line.
- Follow the designated traffic flow pattern. Do not skip through the serpentine pattern under any circumstance.
- Parents are to remain in the vehicle. Staff are present to help students in/out of vehicles as needed.
- Children should practice buckling and unbuckling their seatbelt, opening and closing car doors, and memorizing their car line number.
- Please be sure to have your car line number displayed in the windshield/window of your vehicle during car line.
- Do not release your child(ren) from the vehicle until staff signal it is safe to do so.
- Do not drive out of car line until staff have waved you on to the exit.
